

## REQUIRED INTERNSHIP MATERIALS

At beginning of the program: All interns are required to have the following computer software and connections, other supportive materials, and textbooks - **no exceptions**:

### 1. COMPUTER INFORMATION:

The Dietetics Internship uses Blackboard Learn (Bb) for course delivery.

- Access to the internet - High speed internet access required, no dial-up modem
